It has been arranged **on this day only** for the 18.02 train from Worcester Foregate Street, to call additionally at Ascott-under-Wychwood, arriving at 19.00.

**Adult Off-peak Day Return fare to Worcester - £12.70.**

These special train services have been arranged with First Great Western by the Cotswold Line Promotion Group, which exists to encourage the fullest use of the Oxford-Worcester-Hereford line. The Group has always regretted the decision made when the current franchise was let to FirstGroup Plc, not to require any train service at weekends for Ascott-under-Wychwood, and needs to provide evidence that the residents of the village would appreciate such a service and would use it. This 4-week experiment should provide such evidence, one way or the other. Therefore, if you wish the CLPG to pursue a regular Saturday service when the Greater Western Franchise comes up for renewal in 2013, PLEASE support these trains.
