## Travelling with a bike?

We can only carry folding bikes on replacement buses.

The normal cycle policy for all train companies will apply during these works.

### Between Oxford and London

Customers should use Chiltern Railways services to and from London Marylebone.

There are 2 bicycle spaces on each train which are unreservable.

### Trains between Oxford and Worcester

There are 2 bicycle spaces on each train which are unreservable.

### Trains between Worcester and London Paddington (limited service)

Up to 6 bikes can be carried on-board, and reservations are required as normal.

# Upgrading the railway near Oxford

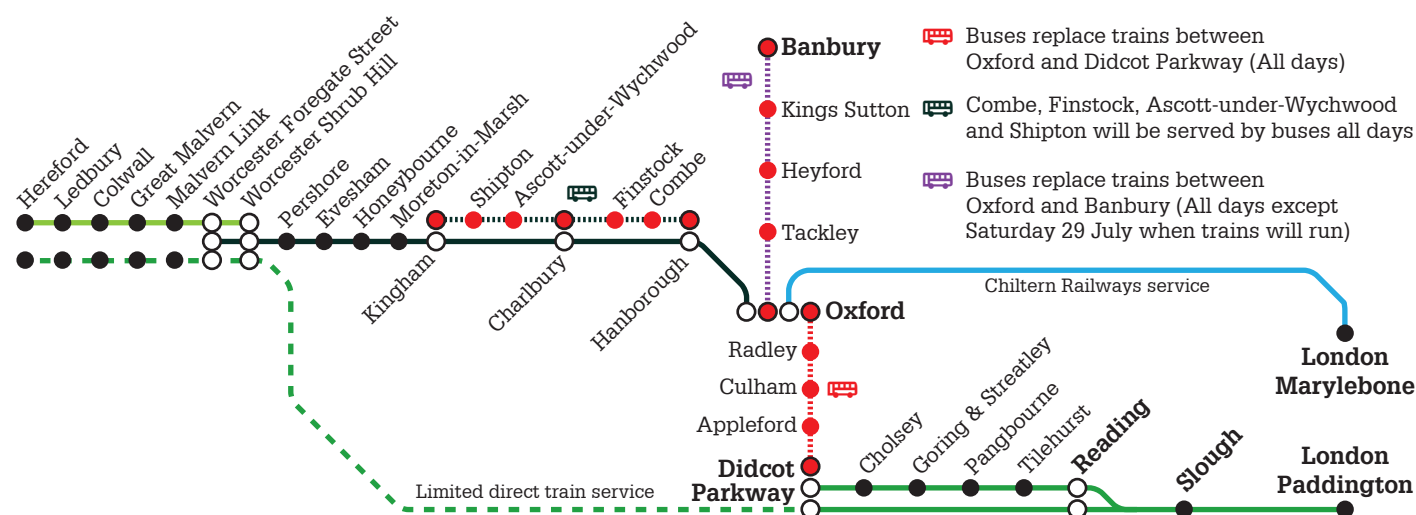
Saturday 22 – Sunday 30 July 2017

## How will train services be affected?

### Travelling from Oxford

- For London we recommend you travel to London Marylebone on a Chiltern Railways service
- For Didcot Parkway travel by replacement bus
- For Banbury travel by replacement bus, except on Saturday 29 July when trains will be running
- For stations to Worcester, an hourly train service will be running offering standard class only

### Travelling from stations between Pershore and Hanborough

- An hourly train service will run between Oxford and Worcester offering standard class only
- For London change at Oxford for Chiltern Railways services to London Marylebone
- For Didcot Parkway change at Oxford for a replacement bus
- For Great Malvern and Hereford change in Worcester
- Buses will run to and from Combe, Finstock, Ascott-under-Wychwood and Shipton

### Travelling from stations between Hereford and Worcester

- An amended train service will run between Hereford and Worcester
- An hourly train service will run between Worcester and Oxford offering standard class only
- A limited number of through services will run between Hereford, Worcester and London Paddington. At all other times please travel to London Euston via Birmingham New Street. Tickets will be valid on London Midland and Virgin Trains services

### Travelling from stations between Radley and Appleford

- Buses will be running between Oxford and Didcot Parkway

### Travelling from stations between Banbury and Tackley

- Buses will be running between Banbury and Oxford, except on Saturday 29 July when trains will be running
- Chiltern Railways services will be running from Banbury to London Marylebone as normal

### Travelling from stations between Didcot Parkway and Tilehurst

- Buses will be running between Didcot Parkway, Oxford and Banbury
- Trains will continue to run between Didcot Parkway and London Paddington



## Car parking changes

### Oxford

Some of the spaces in Becket Street car park will be unavailable from 2000 on Wednesday 19 July until 1200 on Monday 31 July to allow for the bus operation.

### Didcot Parkway

There will be a limited number of car parking spaces available due to the construction of a new multi-storey car park.
